Be eager to share the sorrows of others.


Be a leader when you see a path others have missed. Be a follower when you are shrouded by uncertainty.

REVEAUMS >>> the «« invisible

Create some invisible art and then reveal the seasonal design.

What you need:

- Leaves
- White paper
- White crayon (label removed)
- Watercolor paints
- Water
- Paintbrush

What you do:

- 1. Gather leaves of different shapes and sizes. On a table, arrange them flat without overlaps. Set the paper over them.
- 2. Hold the crayon sideways and use the long edge to color over the leaves. You'll make an invisible rubbing of them.
- 3. Then paint over the paper with watercolors. The areas with crayon will resist the paint and reveal the hidden leaf designs.
