WOZ SPIRITUAL LIFE

I'VE BEEN READING A BOOK CALLED "KEEP IT SHUT" BY KAREN EHMAN. IT IS A CHRISTIAN BOOK THAT SPEAKS ABOUT THE POWER OF OUR WORDS. I THOUGHT I WOULD SHARE SOME OF MY RECENT TAKEAWAYS.

IN THE BOOK SHE STATED THAT WE USE WORDS SEVERAL TIMES A DAY, IN CONVERSATIONS WITH OUR FAMILY, FRIENDS, COWORKERS, AND STRANGERS AS WELL AS IN TEXT AND EMAIL. SHE STATES "ONE THING IS CERTAIN WHEN IT COMES TO OUR WORDS: THEY ARE POWERFUL, AND THEY HAVE CONSEQUENCES. THEY CAN ENCOURAGE OR EMBITTER, BLESS OR BADGER, BUILD-UP OR BREAK DOWN. THE TONGUE HAS THE POWER OF LIFE AND DEATH (PROV. 18: 21)."

SHE GOES ON TO SAY, "COMBATIVE WORDS HAVE SPARKED WARS, BRINGING ABOUT DEATH AND DESTRUCTION. SOOTHING WORDS HAVE CALMED SOULS, QUIETED HEARTS, AND PREVENTED VOLATILE SITUATIONS. ENCOURAGING WORDS HAVE IMPORTED BRAVERY AND EMPOWERED DOUBTING SOULS. LOVING WORDS HAVE BIRTHED RELATIONSHIPS."

SHE WRITES THAT "WE HAVE A CHOICE. CHOOSE WISELY. BE CHOOSEY." WE CAN CHOOSE TO USE OUR WORDS TO BRING JOY OR TO MINDLESSLY SPREAD GOSSIP. WE NEED TO THINK OF THE CONVERSATIONS WE ARE HAVING AND THE WORDS WE ARE SPEAKING. THEY MAY BE ABLE TO BRING PEOPLE CLOSER TO JESUS, OR THEY MAY HAVE THE POWER TO PUSH PEOPLE AWAY FROM JESUS.

I MUST CHOOSE HOW I USE MY WORDS, BUT IT CANNOT BE BOTH. I NEED TO MAKE IT A PRIORITY TO USE MY WORDS TO SPEAK LOVE AND KINDNESS, NOT GOSSIP. I NEED TO CHOOSE TO USE MY CONVERSATIONS IN A WAY THAT WILL SHED LIGHT ON JESUS, WITH JOY AND COMPASSION.

"FATHER, MAKE ME MINDFUL TODAY OF THE WAY I INTERACT WITH OTHERS. MAY I PRAISE AND NOT PUT DOWN. MAY MY WORDS IMPART GRACE TO OTHERS AND NOT SHOW GRUMPINESS. I WANT TO SPRING FORTH WORDS OF LIFE THAT REFRESH THE SPIRIT AND POINT OTHERS TO YOU. IN JESUS'S NAME, AMEN."


