



## **WOZ SPIRITUAL LIFE**

#### **OUR DAILY BREAD**

PASTOR'S RECENT SERMON GOT ME THINKING ABOUT GOD AS MY DAILY BREAD. IT LED ME TO ASK MYSELF:

AM I FEEDING MY SOUL WITH JESUS EVERY DAY? HOW AM I SPENDING MY TIME—FIRST THING IN THE MORNING, THROUGHOUT THE DAY, AND IN THE EVENING? IS GOD THE FIRST THOUGHT WHEN I WAKE UP AND THE LAST ONE BEFORE I SLEEP? AM I ACTIVELY SEEKING HIS PRESENCE THROUGHOUT THE DAY?

THESE QUESTIONS LED ME TO REFLECT ON WHAT THE WORD SAYS ABOUT GOD BEING OUR DAILY BREAD. HERE ARE A FEW SCRIPTURES THAT SPOKE TO ME:

\*MARK 1:35 – "VERY EARLY IN THE MORNING, WHILE IT WAS STILL DARK, JESUS GOT UP, LEFT THE HOUSE, AND WENT OFF TO A SOLITARY PLACE, WHERE HE PRAYED."

THIS VERSE REMINDS ME THAT, LIKE JESUS, STARTING MY DAY WITH GOD IS CRUCIAL. IT'S A TIME TO CONNECT WITH HIM, ACKNOWLEDGE HIS LOVE. AND SEEK HIS GUIDANCE.

\*PSALM 143:8 – "LET THE MORNING BRING ME WORD OF YOUR UNFAILING LOVE, FOR I HAVE PUT MY TRUST IN YOU. SHOW ME THE WAY I SHOULD GO, FOR TO YOU I ENTRUST MY LIFE."

EACH MORNING, I CAN REMIND MYSELF OF GOD'S UNFAILING LOVE AND TRUST IN HIS DIRECTION FOR MY LIFE.

\*PSALM 4:8 – "IN PEACE I WILL LIE DOWN AND SLEEP, FOR YOU ALONE. LORD. MAKE ME DWELL IN SAFETY."

THIS IS A COMFORTING REMINDER THAT ENDING MY DAY WITH THE LORD GIVES ME PEACE. TRUSTING HIM TO WATCH OVER ME BRINGS REST TO MY SOUL.

\*1 CHRONICLES 16:11 – "SEEK THE LORD AND HIS STRENGTH; SEEK HIS PRESENCE CONTINUALLY!"

THIS VERSE IS A CALL TO NOT JUST START AND END MY DAY WITH GOD, BUT TO SEEK HIS PRESENCE THROUGHOUT EVERY MOMENT. AND FINALLY, MY FAVORITE VERSE I FOUND, WHICH I BELIEVE ENCAPSULATES IT ALL:

\*PSALM 63:1 – "YOU, GOD, ARE MY GOD; EARNESTLY I SEEK YOU; MY SOUL THIRSTS FOR YOU, MY BODY LONGS FOR YOU, IN A DRY AND WEARY LAND WHERE THERE IS NO WATER."

THIS SPEAKS TO THE DEEP LONGING WE SHOULD HAVE FOR GOD, LIKE A THIRST THAT ONLY HE CAN SATISFY.


